Conclude Multi-Year Agreement for New Haven Biodiesel Plant

NEW HAVEN, Conn., November 30, 2011 – Greenleaf Biofuels, LLC, announced today that Omaha, Neb.-based Tenaska BioFuels, LLC (TBF), an affiliate of Tenaska, has signed an exclusive multi-year agreement to supply feedstock and sell biodiesel fuel from Greenleaf Biofuel’s New Haven, Conn., plant.
